I glanced through the History of Wood Badge in the U.S. and didn't see any reference. Nor did I find any in my collection of cheers. The only thing close was a note in camp staff log book from back in 75 when we had a Camp Director that absolutely drilled into his staff that an announcement should state who, what, when, where, why, and how. As might be expected he was notorious in making announcements that honored his rule in the breach. The Staff frequently responded back to him in the Dining Hall with Who? Who?, When? When?, Why? Why?, How? How?, etc. In this case I don't think it was an accolade.
